When a lightning strike ignited a manufacturing plant, threatening production and FDA compliance, Compass delivered both immediate emergency response and complete restoration - on time and on budget, at \$8.1M.

Through innovative temporary solutions including FDA-compliant clean rooms and equipment relocation, we kept the factory running - significantly reducing BI - throughout the entire 8-month rebuild; proving that precision and partnership can turn catastrophe into continuity.
